

Eurasia Airshow, which will take place at Antalya on 25-28 April 2018, is the only aerospace exhibition in Turkey based on shows including flight demonstrations. Eurasia Airshow aims to be one of the most important airshows such as Paris Airshow, Farnborough Airshow, Dubai Airshow and Singapore Airshow, which have been well recognized in the global aviation industry from past to the present.

Eurasia Airshow aims to develop a business volume of multi billions in the commercial and military aviation sectors. The world's major players in aviation and aerospace industry, approximately 70 percent of whom are from overseas and 30 percent of whom are domestic, will gather at Eurasia Airshow.

Within Antalya International Airport, there will be a total of 300 thousand square meters of area, 50 thousand square meters closed, 65 business chalets and static exhibition area for more than 100 planes. In addition to over 1000 international participants, more than 150 military and civilian delegations and more than 100 thousand professional visitors from more than 100 countries are targeted.

Eurasia Airshow will be held at Antalya International Airport, one of the first three busiest airports in Turkey with sufficient infrastructure and size in terms of being able to exhibit the flight capabilities of the major players of aviation and aerospace industry. In this scale, Antalya has been selected in accordance with the performance criteria comprising of technical and operational infrastructure availability, meeting military aircraft technical requirements, ground handling capacity, entertainment and shopping facilities, accommodation capacity, accessibility and convenient weather conditions. Another important reason for this preference is the international success of the G20 Summit hosted in this same location at 2015. Antalya is one of the important tourism centers of Turkey and the world, which is also one of the factors that will draw the attention to this trade show.

Eurasia Airshow will be realized under auspices of Presidency of Turkish Republic, with the support and collaboration of significant public institutions and organizations, such as Turkish Armed Forces General Staff, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Ministry of National Defense, the Ministry of Transport, Maritime Affairs and Communication, the Undersecretariat of Defense Industry, General Directorate of State Airports Operations, General Directorate of Civil Aviation, and Turkish Airlines.
